(Roland Emmett continued from last month) In 1953 Malcolm Muggeridge became editor of Punch and began systematic changes, but Emett continued to publish his work there, albeit less frequently. After a spread in Life magazine on 5 July 1954, his work was much in demand in the United States.

He turned more and more to designing and supervising the building of what he called his "things" – always with silly names such as The Featherstone-Kite Openwork Basketweave Mark Two Gentleman's Flying Machine, two copies of which exist, one of which was displayed in a glass case in the Merrion Centre, Leeds, the other on permanent display at the Mid-America Science Museum in Hot Springs, Arkansas. In the mid-1960's he was commissioned by Honeywell to create a mechanical computer, which he named The Forget-Me-Not Computer. In 1968 he designed the elaborate inventions of Caractacus Potts (played by Dick Van Dyke) for the film Chitty Chitty Bang Bang. In 1973 his water-powered musical clock, The Aqua Horological Tintinnabulator, was installed on the lower floor of the Victoria Centre, Nottingham, until 2010. In 2015 it was reinstalled, refurbished and in full working order, to a new location on the upper mall. When commissioned, it played Rameau's Gigue en rondeau II from the E-minor suite of his Pièces de Clavecin when striking the hour and half hour. Later modification en-

abled it to perform every fifteen minutes (the playback system was changed from tape to compact disc).[4][5] Whimsical map of Hemel Hempstead and its neighbours, erected in 1960 on the side of what is claimed to be the first multi-storey car park in the UK

A 30-foot-square mosaic by Emett, installed around 1960, can be seen on the side of the NCP car park in The Marlowes, Hemel Hempstead.

The Cats Cradle Pussiewillow III clock was commissioned by Basildon New Town and inaugurated by Michael Bentine on 7 August 1981. It is on display at Eastgate Shopping Centre in Basildon.

His larger works, such as Emettland, went on extended tours, ending up in prestigious venues such as the Smithsonian Institution in Washington, D.C., The Ontario Science Centre in Toronto has a collection of about ten Emett creations and every December displays the restored working pieces, usually under the title "Dream Machines".

The Mid-America Science Museum has had four of his inventions on permanent display for most of the museum's existence.

When asked how he came up with his strange designs, Emett remarked, "It is a well known fact that all inventors get their first ideas on the back of an envelope. I take slight exception to this, I use the front so that I can incorporate the stamp and then the design is al-

Honours: In the 1978 New Year Honours, described as

"Artist and Inventor", he was awarded an OBE.

He died on 13 November 1990 in a Sussex nursing home.

Exhibitions: There is a permanent exhibition of representative examples of Emett's work at Stoneywish Nature reserve in Ditchling.

An exhibition of Emett's work was held at the Chris Beetles Gallery in London, and an accompanying fully illustrated catalogue written by Jacqui Grossart, entitled Rowland Emett from "Punch" to "Chitty-Chitty-Bang-Bang" and Beyond, was published by Chris Beetles Ltd. in 1988.

Until the early 2000s, the "Featherstone-Kite Openwork Basketweave The Cats Cradle Pussiewillow III clock Mark Two Gentleman's Flying Ma-

chine" was on permanent display in the Merrion Centre, Leeds in England in its own glass display cabinet, and activated every 30 minutes demonstrating the kinetic functions of the sculpture. It has since been re-

> sculptures owned by the Centre's management.

> An exhibition entitled Engines of Enchantment: The Cartoons and Machines of Rowland Emett, with accompanying lectures (including one by his daughter), was held at The Cartoon Museum in London in 2009.

> In 2014, the Birmingham Museum and Art Gallery held an exhibition of Rowland Emett's cartoons and machines, including the five surviving 'inventions' from Chitty-Chitty-Bang-Bang (all in working order), television interviews with Emett, and cinefootage of the 1951 Festival of Britain railway. The BMAG cites "This exhibition will be the

biggest ever display of Emett's work, which is loved by many across the world and will tell the story of his life, living and working in Birmingham."

Spurred on by this result, she then attempts to revitalise her career by forging letters from deceased authors and playwrights such as Dorothy Parker and Noel Coward enlisting the help of her drinking buddy, Jack, who assists by hawking them round bookshops with quite some success initially. Lee believes that hers are better than the originals! Hugely entertaining film with brilliant performances from Melissa McCarthy and Richard E Grant.

It was a pleasure to welcome back Mr Tony Turner whose expected talk on the construction of the Suez Canal had to be postponed due to technical difficulties but replaced by a fascinating account of the fortunes of the famous Tea Clipper, the Cutty Sark. Built in 1869, the vessel had a chequered career, initially sailing to China with general cargo and returning to England with a consignment of tea, running into many tons. Built for speed, although she was not quite the fastest clipper on the China Tea Run. Cutty Sark collected her final tea cargo in 1877 and from then traded in general cargo

such as coal and wool and other commodities. She was then sold to a Portuguese company and renamed Ferreira.

She returned to England after being purchased from her last owners by a retired sea captain who in 1923 restored her to her original name, and subsequently gifted her to the Thames Nautical Training College.

Now fully restored after a disastrous fire in 2007 she was reopened to the public in 2012 and can be seen in Greenwich.

After a vote of thanks to Mr Turner for his excellent talk, tea was served and the raffle drawn.

PROSTATE CANCER AWARENESS MONTH:

March is Prostate Cancer Awareness Month. Organised by Prostate Cancer UK, this special month aims to raise awareness of prostate cancer, as well as raise money so the charity can provide even better support to both sufferers and their families.

The prostate (found only in men), is located just below the bladder and produces some of the fluid in semen. The prostate fluid protects sperm during intercourse. While the prostate often enlarges as men get older, for many men it doesn't cause any problems.

Prostate cancer is important because of the total number of men nationally and worldwide that are affected. Prostate cancer affects 40,000 men in the UK every year. It is estimated that 250,000 men in the UK live with prostate cancer but sadly 10,000 of them will die of the disease each year. It is most common in older men with the majority of newly diagnosed men in their 70s to 80s. It is rare for men to have prostate cancer under the age of 50.

There are strong familial links in prostate cancer with men being two and a half times more likely to get prostate cancer if their brother has prostate cancer. Black Caribbean or black African men have three times greater risk than white men.

The common symptoms of prostatic enlargement are reduced urine flow, increased number of day and night

voids, urgency, hesitancy at the start and a persistent dribble towards the end of urine flow. However, these symptoms merely indicate an increase in prostate size and not of the nature of this enlargement and are therefore a poor indicator for the presence of cancer.

If you are suffering from any of these symptoms, the prostate can be assessed with a rectal examination, which will highlight if the prostate is enlarged, and a blood test. The higher the score of the PSA (Prostate Specific Antigen) then the higher the risk of cancer being present. This test is a good indicator but not always conclusive and further tests may be required.

It comes as figures show more than half of men don't actually know where their prostate is. It's the second biggest cancer killer in men.

Dan Magrill, Consultant Urologist explains 'World Kidney Day is an important annual campaign, encouraging people to ensure good kidney health.' With 1 in 11 people getting stone symptoms in their lifetime, including severe pain, nausea and the constant urge to urinate, we ask Dan for his top tips to prevent kidney stones.

Drink plenty of water to flush bacteria and toxins out of your body, reduce the risk of kidney stones and maintain your general urological health. Keep well hydrated, especially when engaging in activities that cause you to sweat. Drink throughout the day, rather than lots in one go. There's no need to drink expensive bottled water: tap water is just as good!

A tip I share with most of my patients is adding lemon juice to your drinks, this increases the levels of natural stone inhibitors in your urine.

Don't restrict your calcium intake, studies show that a normal calcium intake actually protects you from future stones; a low calcium diet can increase your chance of stones.

Certain foods linked to kidney stones include artificial sweeteners found in diet soft drinks, acidic food, such as citrus, tomatoes, apples, and spicy foods. Most people aren't aware that animal proteins can increase your risk of stones and are in fact acidic and so can irritate the bladder.

If you're prone to kidney stones avoid oxalate-rich foods such as rhubarb, celery, spinach, beetroot and sesame seeds. Black tea, chocolate and nuts are all moderately high in oxalate. Take them in moderation. Avoid tinned, packet or processed foods all of which have a high salt content too!



COMMON SEAL - HERE BE MONSTERS Leg-

end has it that it's been visiting Lewes for years. There have been sightings from Southease all the way up to Barcombe. In January, John glimpsed it vanishing into the murky waters of the River Ouse near Tesco. A few months later, Barry was on his way to work when he encountered the creature hauled out on a pontoon by the Cuilfail cliffs. You'll find 38 species of wild mammal living in or around Lewes. Badgers, foxes, stoats, weasels, shrews, rabbits, hares, moles, voles, dormice, bats, rats, hedgehogs, mice and mink all form the mammalian fauna of a landlocked South Downs town. Yet there's one salty surprise on the list; the Common Seal, an animal that's typically found in Britain's coastal waters 12 kilometres away.

And the seal's certainly a surprise to any Lewes residents who, while innocently strolling along the Ouse, encounter their local leviathan. I've never seen the legendary beast myself but have received plenty of excited tweets, emails and mobile phone photos from amazed

observers who can't believe what they've seen. Throughout history, sailors (without the benefit of smartphones and a Twitter account) have confused seals for mermaids and sea serpents and, as Sussex mammals go, this seal is a real monster.

Common Seals can weigh up to 150 kg; twice the weight of a Fallow Deer, the second biggest wild mammal in this area (and 50,000 times heavier than the smallest; the Pygmy Shrew). As you'd imagine, on land this blubbery behemoth is about as agile as Peter Ustinov trapped in a sleeping bag but underwater they're as balletic as Baryshnikov, gracefully swimming at speeds of up to 25 mph as they hunt fish, shell-fish, squid and octopus.

It's this quest for food that occasionally leads seals into Sussex rivers such as the Ouse and the Arun as they follow fish migrating upstream. Common Seals breed in Sussex, where there is a colony at Chichester Harbour. It's a sink or swim situation for seal pups born on the sandbanks exposed during the low tides of summer. Their aquatic life starts as the next high tide rolls in and within hours of their birth they're swimming in the Solent alongside their mother. Mother's milk helps them to double their birth weight in just a few weeks. The name 'common' is a bit of a misnomer. In British waters you're three times more likely to see their larger,

Roman-nosed relative the Grey Seal. The patterns on each seal's fur are as individual as fingerprints. Keep an eye out when you're next walking by along a Sussex riverbank and see if a seal is giving the river its approval.
