





NEWS FROM STONEYWISH A great cacophony rises from the ponds these mornings, as the geese prepare for mating. Especially vocal are the Canada geese, which take off and circle the farm, honking all the way with their distinctive hiccoughing calls. The jackdaws are pairing too and within their gathered flocks, at dawn and dusk, you can see that the birds are actually flying two-by-two. Our winter redwings and phalaropes are gone, but the blackbirds have found their voices and wagtails, robins, woodpeckers, (green and lesser spotted), tits of all kinds, wrens, thrushes and mistle thrushes have all been making a cheerful din together. The spring weather has hastened the end of the snowdrops here but the Reserve is brightening with warm patches of colour as primroses and daffodils emerge in their place.

Having managed to break my wrist at Christmas I have had a lazy winter, Michael taking over my job of feeding the geese till I can lift the buckets again. Two days ago the fox broke into the hen-run and took our chickens, so we have been feeling sorely aggrieved and mindful that it is the beginning of Lent next week and we shall soon be needing good eggs for pancakes! An old friend has fortuitously offered us some bantams, so we are now busy preparing an impenetrable run for them and hope for better luck.

Michael's new exhibition of vintage photos goes on display when we re-open on 1st March and runs until the end of April at the Visitor Centre in Spatham Lane.

As Lent approached, with the ghastly prospect of a month of gruel and no sausages, the birds, and especially those precious egglaying hens, held all the hopes for future prosperity. WINDMILL PAINTING TIME APPROACHES! Have you ever painted a real windmill? Now is your chance! For newcomers to the village, Oldland Windmill is one of the oldest regularly working windmills in the country being built around 1700. We now produce stone ground flour which may be purchased on site or through our growing number of retail outlets including local garden centres, farm shops and the Ditchling Museum. Thursdays remain our regular volunteers working day throughout the year but we've now returned to our previous practice of adding Tuesdays as well due to popular demand! Do call in if you're taking a stroll past the mill.

The sweeps (the Sussex term for sails) are taken down for a thorough refurbishment every seven years. Two were refurbished last year and the remaining pair will be addressed this year. As in previous years we invite our members, friends and neighbours to help with the repainting; you'll be surprised what a large area there is to paint when you see the sweeps close up on the ground! They are over 30 ft long and 7 ft wide (or 9.3 m by 2.1 m for all those younger readers) and each contain 51 cedarwood shutters. The whole process will run from mid-April until Mid-July and we will be organising small working parties at the mill on every week day. We will also run some sessions on Saturdays to enable supporters working during the week to take part. There is no need to be an expert as guidance will be given and every group will be led by an experienced mill volunteer. All tools and materials will, of course, be provided. We have already contacted our 'regulars' from previous years, but should you wish to join our team this year, please contact John Pryse: Telephone 01444 871734 (or email: j.pryse@btinternet.com) letting him know on which day or days of the week you can attend. Thank you.

Notwithstanding the sweep refurbishment this year, we will continue to run our popular traditional open days on the first Sunday of each month from April to October inclusive. However, we will focus on two rather than three major 'Event Days' this year, the two being 'Music and Morris' on Sunday 5th May and 'History and Heritage' on Sunday 1st September. Plan (BAP). In 2015, The State of Britain's Hedgehogs, by People's Trust for Endangered Species (PTES) and the British Hedgehog Preservation Society (BHPS), outlined the findings of four surveys recording hedgehogs in urban and rural areas, and showed a worrying decline in hedgehog numbers. Hedgehogs continue to face pressures in the rural landscape and from urban development, but monitoring numbers, and initiatives such as 'Hedgehog Street' and 'Hedgehog Heroes', plus public efforts to improve garden habitats and connectivity, might just give them a fighting chance.
