It is a new-fledged wren, taking stock of his world. Perception narrows to this tiny point and I am rooted there as long as he continues undisturbed. Oh for a camera now! But to 'capture' this moment would be to flatten it and lose its essence. This is something far more precious. As I watch, my sensibility expands, takes in the tangle of leaves, not as a tangle now,

but rather, as something spacious and inviting, as a tiny bird might see it, offering an infinite complexity of footholds and galleries and cathedral-like domed spaces for exploration. The background blur of sounds, untangle themselves and now I can hear the grasshopper rattle of other voices too. There are four of them altogether. A whole nestful of youngsters, hopping warily from branch to branch, while the parents, hidden from view, offer covering fire with their hullabaloo. Ah, now I understand what is going on. The enigma has been solved. But something else has happened too and I beat a retreat to reflect.

This month's history morning takes place on Friday 30th August. As seems only fitting for a summer holiday event, we are off to the coast, with Beside the Sea: An 18th Century Tourist visits Littlehampton and Brighton. An authority in the field, our speaker, David Dawson, invites us into the antiquarian book-lover's 'back room' to turn the pages of a real collector's item. Here is the record of a fortnight's trip to Sussex, nearly 250 years ago. By 1780 Brighton had entered its early years as the leading South Coast resort, whilst westwards, at Littlehampton, attempts were being made to become, if not its rival, certainly an alternative (and quieter) choice. Our holidaymaker's fascinating and rare book, describing both places – sometimes in unexpected detail - is believed to be the first contemporary printed account of a seaside holiday. Don't miss this one. You will never see these familiar places the same again. The talk begins at 10.30 at the Visitor Centre in Spatham Lane. Talks are accompanied by an exhibition of

Lupins there. Clumps of colour. Everything behind its respective fence. This way we can enjoy a sense of control. A jungle may be fine in faraway places – the Amazon, say. But not here. Not unless, it is a designated place, with an information board and a proper viewing platform provided. What we do not realise is that the wilderness is actually inside us, in the teaming masses of bacteria which outnumber our body cells 10 to 1 and keep us alive; in the water we drink – yes – even chlorinated water! In the air we breathe; the rain that waters our gardens. Every attempt we make to 'capture' and contain the wildness merely disconnects us from the worldwide web of life to which we naturally belong. If we would find a solution to the ills we inflict on the world, I cannot help thinking a change of mindset must come first. Let's put away our cameras, textbooks, databases... and just look. And not just look but open and enlarge our senses to seek the miraculous patterns and messages encoded in the humblest forms of life. Let's be captivated. Let's ask which really needs to be saved. Is it Nature? Or is it ourselves? In this jungle by the Black Swan Pond is a web of noxious weeds: nettles, scotch

thistles, teasels and hogweed with lesser species threaded in between. Of all the plants here, it is the dreaded hogweed which provides the sweetest feast and insects of all kinds crowd on the flowers: certain bees, hoverflies, bee flies, wasps, myriad flies - a chequered moth no bigger than an apple pip – a harmless wood wasp and countless soldier beetles with their russet wings. On a green seedhead sits a green cricket. All day long. All are in communication with one another, with the scents and chemical messages in the air, with the dragon-flies hawking overhead... I could count the species, tag them, analyse them. Would that help the world? Would it help me? Truly? I am drawn back to the words of one of our visionary poets: the great anti-Newtonian, anti-reductionist, William Blake. To read him is to take, with him, a miraculous 'journey into the interior': "Seest thou the little winged fly, smaller than a grain of sand?/It has a heart like thee; a brain open to heaven and hell./Withinside wondrous and expansive, its gates are not closed." A microscope will not help one see it. This 'withinside' world is visible only to young children, and to those who can, belatedly, 'unclose' their gates of perception. But what a wealth is there! Suddenly, no one is alone. Everything is speaking, vibrating with information. A mere thumbnail becomes a wilderness. And the realisation dawns that Nature is not a state or an external thing to be saved, but 'Human Existence' itself. Unless we wake up to that soon, I am afraid, our only journey will be down the pan. Rosemary

ARE YOU MAN ENOUGH 1 in every 2 men will have a health problem with their prostate at some stage of their lives.

It could be an infection, enlargement or cancer. 1 in every 8 men will develop prostate cancer and those of African-Caribbean origin and those with a family history of the disease are 2 to 3 times more at risk.

PSA stands for Prostate Specific Antigen, it is a simple blood test that measures the amount of antigen, produced by the prostate, entering the blood. It is not a direct test for cancer, a moderately raised reading can be an indicator of a prostate problem, a high reading should trigger further tests to determine if there is a need for any treatment.

Without screening, around 47,000 men are diagnosed with prostate cancer each year. It is now the leading cancer found in men. Around 11,800 men die of this disease annually, one every 45 minutes. Caught in the early stages, cure rates are dramatically improved with over 80% success. General symptoms of problems with the prostate are frequent need to urinate especially at night; bursting to urinate, slow flow, difficult, painful; stop/start and dribbling, or blood in the urine.

The charity PCaSO (Prostate Cancer Support Organisation) in partnership with Burgess Hill District Lions are offering free PSA testing for men aged between 45 and 80 on **12th October** at the Triangle Leisure Centre, Triangle Way, Burgess Hill RH15 8WA. We are also testing in East Grinstead on **23rd November**.



EUROPEAN EEL - ALTERNATING CUR- RENTS In August many of us migrate towards the sea; exchanging our familiar habitats for a few weeks in someplace sunnier and sandier. As we leave our county a mysterious creature, born in the dark depths of a distant ocean, is heading towards Sussex for a holiday of its own.

Let me take you 3500 miles west to the wide Sargasso Sea, an area of the North Atlantic known to superstitious seamen (and Barry Manilow fans) as The Bermuda Triangle. Today the once mythical Sargasso is infamous for being the North Atlantic's waste dump where surface currents deposit our nondegradable floating flotsam. But the Sargasso still holds one last mystery. Each year millions of transparent slithers, like a blizzard of tiny polythene leaves, rise from its depths. It's almost as if the seaweed and the spirits of sunken sailors have merged with the PVC and plastic to create the leptocephali; the larval stage of the European Eel. These seethrough seafarers go with the flow and slowly drift across the North Atlantic on a three-year Gulf Stream cruise.

Upon reaching Britain's coastal waters their appearance changes. They are now wriggling transparent tubes with black eyes; 'glass eels'. Riding the



Rother, Ouse, Cuckmere, Arun and Adur they swim upstream. In these brackish waters their bodies darken; a tidal tan. They are now elvers. They finally make it to their Sussex holiday homes, exchanging saltwater for freshwater in the myriad of streams and brooks that feed our county's rivers. Yellow-bellied and small-eyed these are yellow eels and will holiday here for around 15 to 30 years. But, as with all holidays, the day comes when you have to return home. In the depths of the eel's mind a primeval urge is awakened. The Sargasso is calling. Their bodies harden, their eyes widen, their stomachs shrivel and yellow eels become silver eels and start their epic journey home. Nothing gets in their way. Land, traditionally an inconvenient barrier for a fish, does not stop them. On dark, wet nights the silver eels crawl out of the water, slithering snake-like across fields and back into the river system.

They'll pass Rye, Shoreham, Exceat, Newhaven and Littlehampton and head out over the great Atlantic Shelf and into darkness. Here's where the silver eels vanish. Exactly where they go and how they get there is unknown. Yet each year the Sargasso will mysteriously spawn a new cloud of transparent tourists hell-bent on holidaying in Sussex by the Sea.
